

AACA Accessibility Plan

As a Prescribed Organization under the BC Accessibility Act (2021), Avalon Adventist Christian Academy is required to form an Accessibility Plan. As outlined on the Accessibility BC website (<u>https://bcaccessibilityhub.ca/</u>), AACA will meet the three requirements of the act in the following manner.

- 1. **Committee**: To meet the committee requirements of the Act, AACA is using the committee of Associate Member Society of the FISABC, of which we are a member, as well as a secondary committee of BC principals under the organization: BC Conference of the SDA Church. On a local level, the Emergency Preparedness and Safety Committee (made up of the administrator and teachers at AACA) will be dealing with accessibility matters.
- 2. Plan: AACA will take the following steps in the 2023/24 school year
 - a. We will do an initial assessment of the level of accessibility in our school building to identify strengths and needs. This will be complete by January 1, 2024.
 - b. We will meet the requirements of the Accessibility Act by formulating this plan and posting it on the school website.
